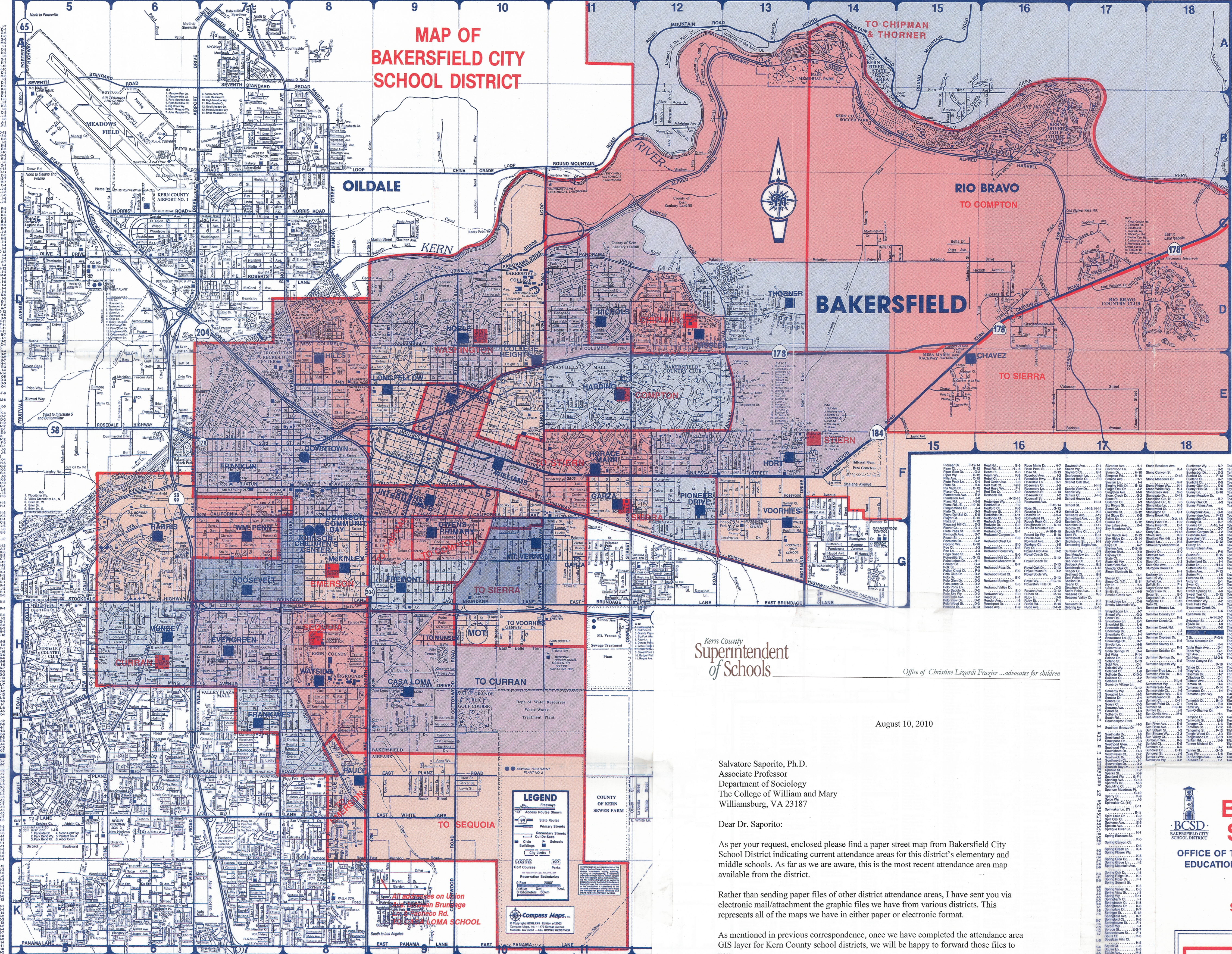


MAP OF BAKERSFIELD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
