### **Description**

Polygons identifying attendance zones for public high schools in Bay County. Information as of November 2008.

For elementary and middle school attendance zones, see school\_zone\_e and school\_zone\_m.

Coordinate system: State Plane, Florida North Zone, Datum NAD83, feet (see .prj file)

#### **Source**

High school attendance zones were adopted by the Bay County School Board on October 13, 1999. Bay County GIS obtained zone descriptions from Bay District Schools (file **geographicalattendancezones2000-2001approvedOctober13,1999.doc**) and created a *draft* polygon shapefile in June 2000. GIS staff used **bocc\_dists**, **county**, **parcels**, **plss**, **roads**, and heads-up digitizing to create the boundary features. Written descriptions from Bay District Schools included beginning on page two.

On November 28, 2000, met with Joette Bruner of Bay District Schools and got questions answered regarding the descriptions of two polys that seemed to overlap; had used wrong 17<sup>th</sup> St for both Bay and Rutherford descriptions.

In late September 2001, made changes to reflect changes mentioned above. In October 2001, met with Joette Bruner, Leona (?), and Rusty Holloway of Bay District Schools; dropped off draft copy of school zone map for their review and School Board approval.

In November 2003, edited layer to include the Bozeman Learning Center. Beginning in the 03-04 school year, the Mosley attendance zone was split into two: Mosley and Bozeman. This affects only 9<sup>th</sup> graders in the 03-04 school year; an additional grade level will be moved to Bozeman each academic year.

In November 2004, obtained new shapefile from Bay County School Board to update data. Deleted legal description at end of documentation. Updated file structure description to reflect changes.

In April 2009, Staff jointly worked with the Bay County School Board to update this shapefile, reflecting changes for the upcoming 2009 – 2010 school year. Updated File structure to reflect changes those changes.
