

During its February 21, 2006 meeting, the Guilford County Board of Education approved redistricting Map C, with a modification, that will affect High Point area middle and high schools.

High school students, who were previously assigned to a high school through the Choice Plan, will have the option to either stay at their Choice high school or to attend their new zoned high school in 2006-07; if they decide to stay at their Choice high school, transportation will be provided. Rising eighth graders will be allowed to stay at their previously assigned middle school without transportation, as outlined in Board Policy JBCC.

**Map C (with a modification) for Middle and High Schools:**

**Effective Fall 2006**

- Assign the Whites Mill Road area (south of Skeet Club Rd.) from Southwest High and Middle to Andrews and Welborn
- Assign the Penny Road area from Southwest High and Middle to Andrews and Welborn
- Assign the Parkview attendance zone from Andrews and Welborn to Southwest High and Middle
- Assign the Leonard Avenue area (south to E. Green Dr. between College Rd. and the 311 Bypass) from Andrews to Southwest High
- Assign the Shadybrook attendance area from Andrews (area east of Johnson St. and west of Oak Hollow Lake) to Central (*reflects the modification made to Map C*)

**Penn-Griffin School for the Arts:**

**Effective Fall 2006**

- The school will begin to serve ninth grade students (with admission by audition; audition not required for middle school students)
- Assign the Shadybrook attendance area served by Penn-Griffin area to Ferndale (**rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders effective during the 2006-07 school year**)
- Assign the Oak View attendance area, west of N. Main St. and served by Penn-Griffin to Ferndale (**rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders effective during the 2006-07 school year**)
- Assign the Shadybrook attendance area, east of Johnson St., to Ferndale from Welborn (**rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders effective during the 2006-07 school year**)
- Assign the Oak View attendance area, east of N. Main St from Penn-Griffin to Welborn (**rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders effective during the 2006-07 school year**)

*Thus making the new Penn-Griffin attendance zone bounded on the north by E. Lexington Ave; to the east by N. College Rd.; to the south by E. Washington Dr.; and to the west by Blain St. (between Lexington/Montlieu) and Montlieu (between Blain/Centennial) and Centennial (between Montlieu /Washington)*
