Unless otherwise specified, all boundary lines refer to an imaginary line down the middle of the street.

MIDDLE SCHOOL BOUNDARIES

Freed

Beginning at a point where the Arkansas River and the west boundary of District 60 would intersect; east on the Arkansas River to a point where the W. 4th Street Bridge and Arkansas River would intersect; east on W. 4th Street to Fountain Creek; north on Fountain Creek to the northern boundary of the District 60 boundary line; east on the northern boundary to its intersecting western boundary.

Heaton

Beginning at a point where Highway 50 Bypass and Fountain Creek would intersect; north on Fountain Creek to the northern boundary of the District 60 line; the northern and eastern boundaries of District 60 are on the Heaton northern and eastern boundaries; from a point where the eastern boundary of District 60 would intersect with AT&SF Railroad tracks; west on these tracks to U.S. Highway 50 Bypass; northwest on the U.S. Highway 50 Bypass to a point where Fountain Creek intersects.

Note: Area on north side of E. 18th Street to U.S. Highway 50 Bypass between Joplin and Reading is neutral area for Risley and Heaton Middle Schools.

Pitts

Starting at a point of Pueblo City School's west boundary and the south bank of the Arkansas River easterly of the south bank of the Arkansas River to a point that intersects the D&RG Railroad tracks. South along the D&RG Railroad tracks to a point that intersects Northern Ave. West on Northern Ave. to a point that intersects Pueblo City School's western boundary. As Northern Ave being the dividing line, the Northern sections being Pitts Middle School boundaries.

Risley

Starting at a point that intersects the Northern bank of the Arkansas River and 4th Street. East on 4th Street to the east bank of the Fountain River. At the point 4th Street intersects the East bank of the Fountain River north to Hwy 50. Easterly on Hwy 50 to a point that intersects County Road. Southwesterly along the Pueblo City School's boundaries to a point that intersects the Arkansas River. At a point that intersects the Arkansas River and Aspen Road to a point intersecting the eastern boundaries of Pueblo City Schools. East along the boundary to a point intersecting 21st Road. South to southern boundary of Pueblo City Schools. West on that point to the intersecting D&RG Railroad. North on the D&RG Railroad tracks to a point that intersects the Arkansas River. 4th Street and Hwy 50 being the dividing lines, Risley Middle Schools boundaries being the southern sections of those roads.

Note: Area on north side of E. 18th Street to U.S. Highway 50 Bypass between Joplin and Reading is neutral area for Risley and Heaton Middle Schools.

Roncalli

Starting at a point of the western boundaries that intersects Hwy 76/Northern Ave. Easterly on Northern Ave. to a point that intersects the D&RG Railroad. South along the D&RG Railroad to a point that intersects the Southern Pueblo City Schools boundary. West on southern boundary to a point that intersects the western boundary of Pueblo City Schools. As Northern Ave being the dividing line, the southern sections being Roncalli Middle School's boundary.
