

New Boundaries Approved

On February 19, 2008, the board of education approved new boundaries for elementary, middle, and high school attendance areas. The new boundaries are in response to the district building its third high school and converting the Waubonsie Valley High School freshman building to its seventh middle school. Opening new schools necessitates changing school boundaries to determine who will attend the new schools.
