DIAMOND FORK JR. HIGH SCHOOL

Spanish Fork City students living east and north of a line beginning at Highway 77 and Main Street, running south to 300 South/Canyon Road, then east to 1400 East, then south to the crest of the hill, then east to 1100 East (county road), then south to the mountain, then southeast to Spanish Fork Canyon; including Covered Bridge, Birdseye, Thistle and Spanish Oaks subdivision.

SPANISH FORK JR. HIGH SCHOOL

Spanish Fork City students living west and south of a line beginning at Highway 77 and Main Street, running south to 300 South/Canyon Road, then east to 1400 East, then south to the crest of the hill, then east to 1100 East (county road), then south to the mountain. Including Salem, Palmyra, Lake Shore, Benjamin, and Leland.

SPANISH FORK HIGH SCHOOL

Spanish Fork City students living west of Highway 6 and west of a line beginning at Highway 6 and Center Street (Spanish Fork), going west to 1150 East, then south to Canyon Road, then east to 1700 East, then south to the crest of the hill, then west to 1100 East (county road), then south to the mountain. Including Palmyra, Lake Shore, Benjamin, and Leland.

SALEM HILLS HIGH SCHOOL (opens fall of 2008)

All students living in Salem, Woodland Hills, and Elk Ridge. Students in Payson City boundaries living north of a line beginning at Highway 6 and 1650 West (county road), south to Salem Canal Road, west on Salem Canal Road to 500 South Goosenest Drive, turning north on 600 East to Highway 6 (includes students on east side of 600 East only), west to 100 West and 100 North, south to 200 South, west to I-15, south to 12000 South, west to 5200 West, south to Strawberry Highline Canal, west to 5950 West, north to the railroad tracks, then west to Highway 141, then north along the mountain to the community of Benjamin, southeast along the Benjamin border to 3200 West, south to the Bamberger Road, east to Arrowhead Trail, then southeast to approximately 1650 West and Highway 6; including all of West Mountain.

MAPLE MOUNTAIN HIGH SCHOOL (opens fall of 2009)

All students living in Mapleton City boundaries. Spanish Fork City students living east of Highway 6 and east of a line beginning at Highway 6 and Center Street (Spanish Fork), going west to 1150 East, then south to Canyon Road, then east to 1700 East, then south to the crest of the hill, then west to 1100 East (county road), then south to the mountain, then southeast to Spanish Fork Canyon; including Covered Bridge, Birdseye, Thistle and Spanish Oaks subdivision.
