Many students will see campus changes at this level


L.E. Monahan Elementary 8901 Deep Valley (light green)

The attendance zone for C. E. King Middle School and Stephanie Cravens ECA is divided into two elementary attendance zones. The dividing line between these two zones is formed by Tidwell Rd. Areas north of Tidwell Rd. are zoned to L.E. Monahan Elementary and areas south of Tidwell Rd. are zoned to Royalwood Elementary.

H. M. Carroll Elementary 10210 C.E. King Pkwy (yellow)

Sheldon Elementary 17203 Hall Sheppard (pink) The attendance zone for Michael R. Null Middle School and Sheldon ECA is divided into two elementary attendance zones. The dividing line between these two zones is formed by Beltway 8. Areas west of Beltway 8 are zoned to H. M. Carroll Elementary and areas east of Beltway 8 are zoned to Sheldon Elementary.



Elementary zones are very likely to change annually as growth continues in the district. Those zones will constantly show fluctuations with student growth and will be altered accordingly.

The early childhood and

middle zones have been set with consideration that the majority of the areas scheduled for home construction are in the areas of Sheldon Academy and Null Middle School's attendance.

Unless the district experi-

ences unexpected growth in families in the Cravens
Academy and King Middle areas, these zones will probably not have to be changed as frequently as elementary zoning will require.

If growth continues in our

district and, at some later date, additional schools are required, the attendance zones will again be changed to best accommodate student populations.
